SHARE OF COST

2021 Monthly cost of skilled nursing: \$10,298

Share of cost = Net Income minus \$35

Single Person Example:

| Net Income = | \$1,000/mo |
|--------------|------------|
| SoC= | \$965/mo |
| State pays | \$9,333/mo |

Deductions from income prior to calculating SoC:

- (a) Insurance premiums
- (b) Old unpaid medical expenses (Hunt v Kizer)
- (c) Medically necessary supplies (Johnson v Rank)
- (d) Maintenance of home (only if returning in 6 months)

Married Couple Examples:

Maximum Monthly Maintenance Needs Allowance (MMMNA) = \$3,260 for 2021

Example One: Community spouse's income less than MMMNA:

| Share of Cost: | \$705 |
|----------------------------------|------------------|
| Inst. Spouse Remaining Income: | \$740 |
| Shift to Com. Spouse: | \$1,260 |
| MMMNA: | \$3,260 |
| Institutionalized Spouse Income: | \$2,000 |
| Community Spouse Income: | \$2 <i>,</i> 000 |

Example Two: Community spouse's income more than MMMNA:

| Share of Cost: | \$1,965 |
|----------------------------------|---------|
| Inst. Spouse Remaining Income: | \$2,000 |
| Shift to Com. Spouse: | \$0 |
| MMMNA: | \$3,260 |
| Institutionalized Spouse Income: | \$2,000 |
| Community Spouse Income: | \$5,000 |
