CCCBA IN-PERSON MEETING REQUIREMENTS

(as of October 13, 2022)

In order to register for a CCCBA in-person event (MCLE, social or otherwise), registrants will have to check a box to indicate agreement with the following:

Your health and safety are important to the CCCBA. By registering for this event, I understand the following:

CCCBA encourages attendees to be fully vaccinated and boosted for Covid19. Attendees who are not fully vaccinated and not current on their boosters are encouraged to wear a mask at all times during the event.

CCCBA expects anyone who is feeling sick, may have symptoms of Covid19 and/or has tested positive for Covid-19 to NOT attend any in person events.

CCCBA will follow all rules or regulations regarding Covid19 from the CDC, State of California, and County of Contra Costa that are in place at the time of the event. CCCBA will also require compliance with all health and safety guidelines, if any, required by the event venue. This may include mask requirements, social distancing, etc.

Event coordinator requirement

Every in-person event shall have a designated event coordinator from the sponsoring committee or section who will check to see if each attendee has pre-registered (and thus agreed to the event attendance requirements above). If an attendee has not pre-registered, the event coordinator will ask them to read the agreement above and sign to indicate their agreement. Those who refuse to sign the agreement will not be admitted.
